Don't tolerate underage drinking

54% of Geauga County 12th graders report that their parents have a favorable attitude toward their alcohol use.

Alcohol kills 6 1/2 times more youth than all other illicit drugs combined.

Alcohol charges against Geauga County minors increased 24% in 2004, and 38% in 2005.

53.7% of Geauga students have used alcohol at least once in their lifetime.

You're the parent – It's your job

- Love as a parent, not as a friend.
- Supervise when your teen has a party.
- Curfews work—use them.
- Stand up for the law. The legal drinking age is 21
